Without question, 9Marks is a beneficiary of the Reformation’s legacy. The truths that Luther, Calvin, and others reclaimed are the same truths we hope to re-popularize today. After all, every local church needs to undergo reformation; every church needs to reorient itself regularly to the standards of God’s Word.

These kinds of **miniature reformations** happen all the time. Here are just a few we’ve been a part of in 2017:

Our managing editor recently met a young man in **New York City** who’d left the prosperity gospel church he’d attended all his life. Why did he leave? Because he found a video online where Mark Dever taught about the gospel and expositional preaching and realized his church wasn’t healthy.

At this year’s **SBC**, Ryan ran into the dean of a large American seminary. He told him that, in almost 20 years of teaching Baptist history and ecclesiology, 2017 featured the first class ever where he didn’t have to convince incoming students about the biblical basis for church discipline. All the questions they asked focused on practical application. “You guys are winning!” he said.

A group of Spanish-speaking pastors from a local church in the **Dominican Republic** attended the 9Marks International Intensive and, based off that experience and our partnership together, successfully implemented an indigenous “Weekender” this Fall in their own local church that served church leaders from 10 countries in the region.

In partnership with 20schemes and Acts 29, we hosted eight **Church In Hard Places** conferences in cities around the world—from Shanghai to Sydney, Johannesburg to Cape Town.

Mark Dever’s book ***What Is a Healthy Church?*** can be found in bookstores in the country of... China! Praise God. Meanwhile, earlier this summer a pastor from the States spent a day meeting with indigenous Chinese pastors in what’s become perhaps the first ever local Baptist association in that great country.

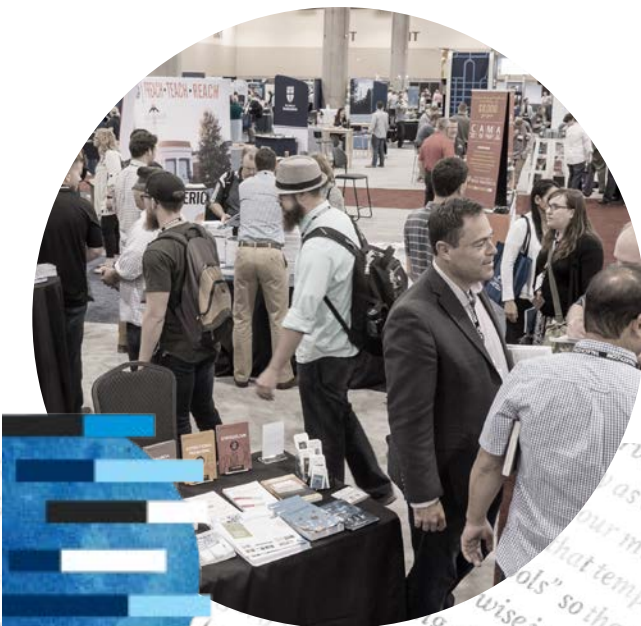
