

Genesis 24 — Preview of the Exodus

Dwelling outside the land	Rebekah – The Bride	Israel – The Bride
Sending of a Servant	Abraham’s “Servant” (Probably Eliezer)	Moses, the “servant of the Lord”
Servant’s reluctance to go	Genesis 24:5	Exodus 3:11
Reminder of God’s Covenant Faithfulness to the Servant	Genesis 24:7	Exodus 3:12–15
Servant proclaims the word of the master / the Lord	Genesis 24:34–49	Moses speaks the word of the Lord to Pharaoh
Angel of the Lord	Genesis 24:7, 40	Exodus 23:20, 23
Laban hesitates / Pharaoh Hesitates	Genesis 24:55	Exodus 8:28–32
Securing a bride	Genesis 24:67	Israel, the bride of YHWH in covenant with him

Exodus and Conquest Sequence in Genesis 26

- 1) Abrahamic Promises (1–5)
- 2) Famine in the Land (1)
- 3) Sojourn / Settling in a foreign land (6ff)
- 4) Accrual of wealth (12–14)
- 5) Multiplication and Increased strength / “You are much mightier than we” (16; cf. Exod. 1:9, “Behold the people of Israel are too many and too mighty for us.”)
- 6) Conflict in the Promised land with surrounding nations (17–21)
- 7) Lord gives peace and “makes room” so that the seed can be “fruitful in the land” (22; on “make room” [Hiphil, *rhb*] cf. Exod. 34:24; Deut. 12:20; 19:8)
- 8) Building an Altar / Calling on the name of the Lord
- 9) Blessed by the nations and a blessing to the nations
